

SINCE 1956, the Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DEA) is an internationally recognized, self-development program that encourages youth between ages 14-25 to: be active; set goals; participate in new and challenging activities; and pursue current interests in four main areas.

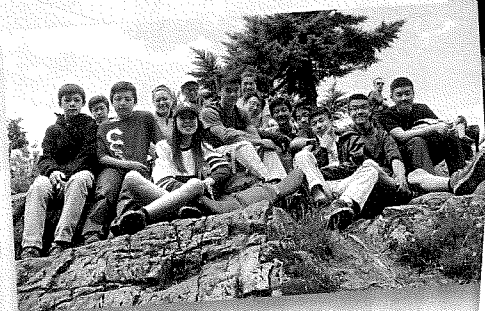
These areas are: **Volunteering, Physical Recreation, Skills and Expedition.**

There are 3 Awards that you can achieve: Bronze, Silver and Gold. Of the 3, most participants start their journey by accomplishing the Bronze Award, and then work their way up towards the Gold Award. The Bronze Award is a year long program, so it's a great way to make new friends too!

To qualify, participants must first register and obtain a Record Book and then satisfy the requirement of the four sections of the program. The Award itself consists of a label pin or brooch, and an inscribed certificate of achievement.

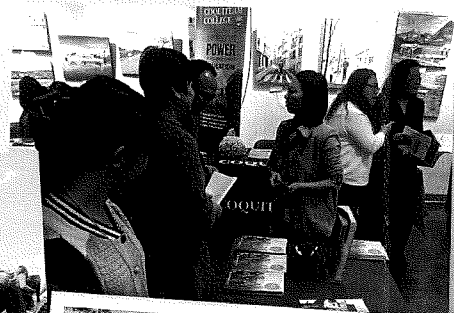
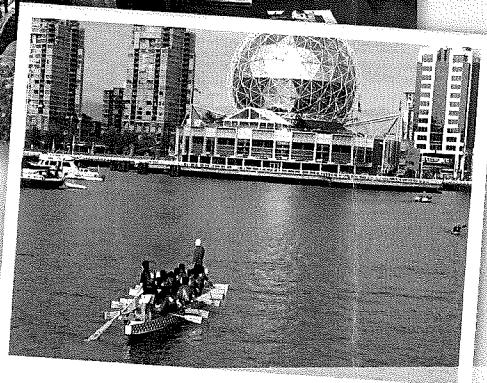

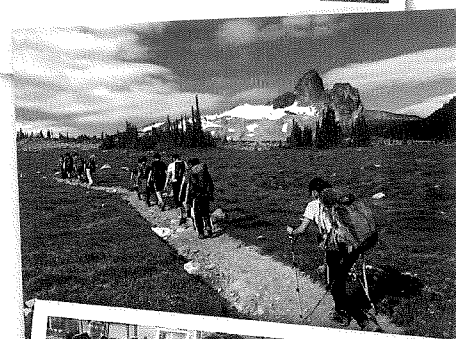
